### Bullying. No Way!

This Friday is the National Day of Action against Bullying. Our classes will be doing activities around the "Bullying No Way!" theme on the day. Bullying is a deliberate ongoing misuse of power in relationships through repeated verbal, physical and/or social behaviour that intends to cause harm. It can involve an individual or a group, over one or more people who feel unable to stop it from happening. Bullying can happen in person or online and is behaviour that is repeated over time.

We have included a tip sheet about what to do if your child tells you about bullying.

### Cyber Safety

Recently we have been made aware of an increasing number of children accessing social media and online sharing sites. Apps like TikTok allow students to post videos of themselves and make comments about things.

## School Times

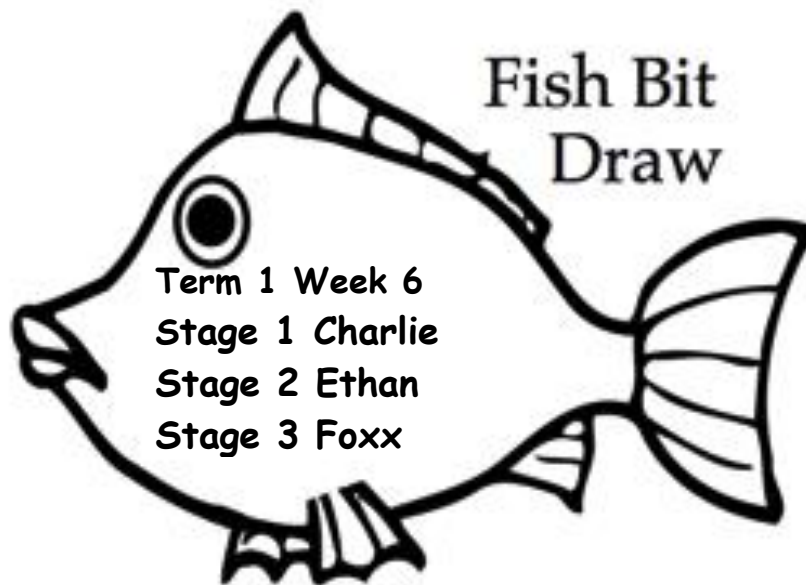
