It has been wonderful to hear about the great learning that has been going on this term during the 3 way interviews. I have been very impressed with the fantastic response from our school community, with nearly all our families coming in this week, making contact by phone or arranging another time. Family support for the students and school is so important in ensuring they make the most of their opportunities to learn and develop into confident, inspiring citizens.

We have a lot of great activities happening over the last 2 weeks of school. Tomorrow (Wednesday) K-2 are involved in an AFL coaching day, while some of our girls will participate in a netball trial day. Next week we have boys participating in a touch football trial on Monday, Wednesday is our School cross country, Thursday is the school disco and Friday we will have the Easter Hat Parade. After that I'm sure we will all be ready for the term holidays.

Great attendance

With only 8 days left in this term, I want to highlight the great attendance of our students.

- 113 of our students have 100% attendance for this term.
- 265 have 2 or less days away.
- 299 have 3 or less days away.

As we know it is important for our students to have regular school attendance not just to be here every day, but also here on time to get the most out of their learning opportunities. What a great start to their year.

Bus safety

All students at some stage of school use buses. Due to their size (both the bus and children), getting off a bus can become a potentially dangerous place. Buses hide children from cars driving by and hide the cars from children. For this reason it is important that children and parents take care around bus stops. Three important messages around bus safety are:

1. Parents picking their children up from bus drop off point should wait on the same side of the road as the student is getting dropped off. This way you can make sure they leave the area safely;

- 2. Students are not to cross the road until the bus has left the stop fully. This way they have a clear view of any traffic that is going past and the drivers can see them; and
- 3. Where seatbelts are provided, they must be worn at all times.






