We are constantly monitoring ways we can make things safer for our students at Broulee PS. Recently we have noticed an increased use of the school carpark area. This is both cars and delivery vehicles as well as bikes, scooters and pedestrians. Nobody wants an accident to happen in that area, so we are putting up signs to remind pedestrians that the carpark is not a pathway.

We are also trialling a change to bikes and scooters entering the school. All students bringing bikes or scooters to school via Cambridge Cres, need to enter at the main front gate. They need to push their bikes along the path next to the canteen and around to the bike racks. Students entering via Captain Oldrey push their bikes past K/1W room to the racks.


Thought for the week:

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
