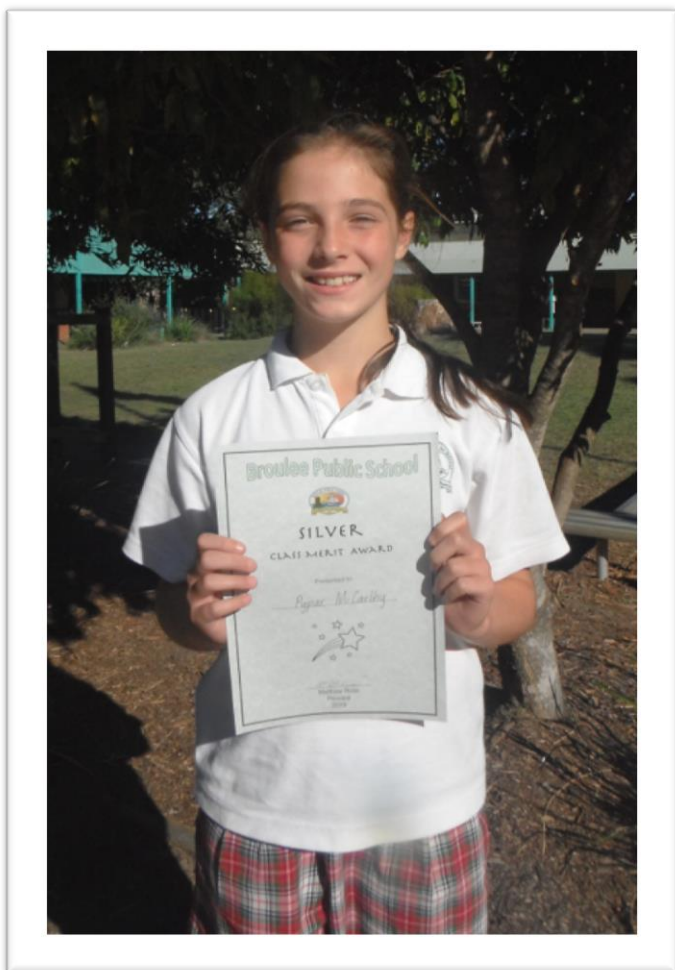

Thank you to the Broulee Fire Brigade for visiting Kindergarten, Year 1 and Year 2 on Wednesday 1 May.



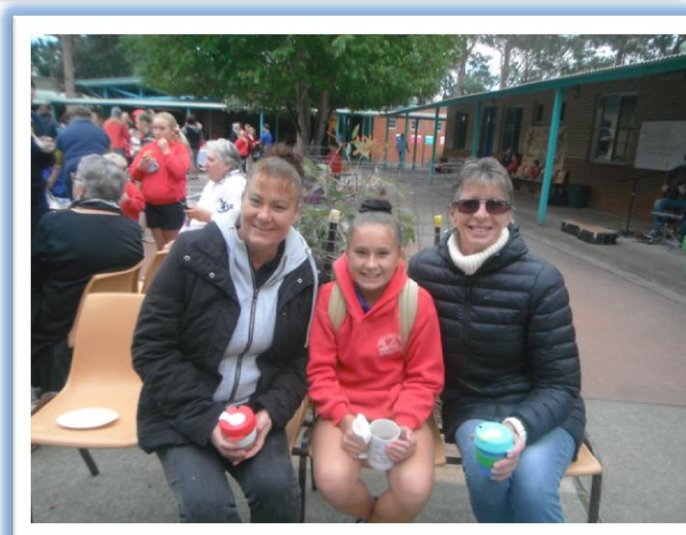
Mothers' Day Stall

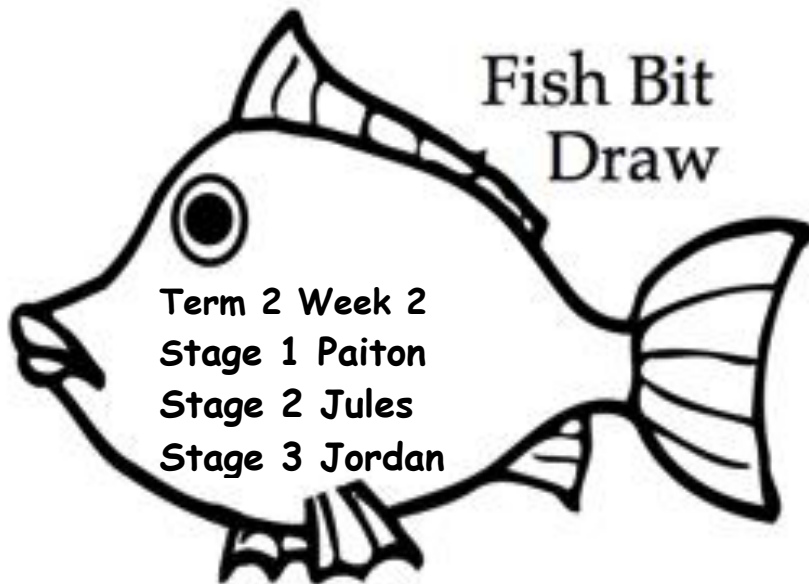

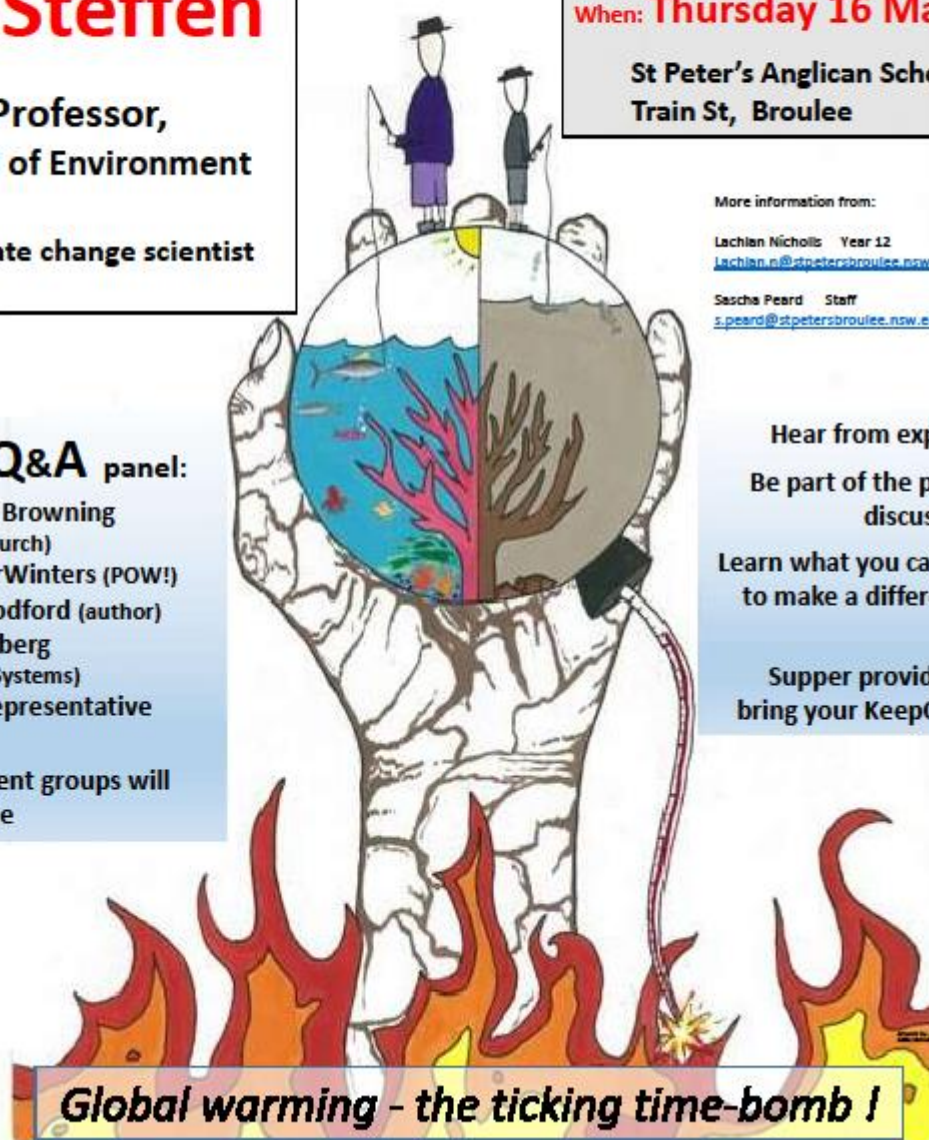
