

Book Fair

Book Fair viewings commence this week with sales next Monday 16th and Tuesday 17th November. There are a few changes this year that you need to be aware of. Sales will be conducted during school time with students as families are not able to attend. Students can bring cash for items such as stationery, posters as well as the items on the Wacky Table (these are all on the red tables); these are limited items and cannot be re-ordered once they sell out.

Online payment is preferred for books and items on the shelves to limit the amount of cash your child brings to school. You can see the pictures of the books available and their prices on our Broulee Public School Facebook page (<https://www.facebook.com/BrouleePS/>). When making an online purchase, please record the title you wish to purchase along with the receipt number and send it in with your child. You cannot choose the title online so please refer to your child's wish lists or to the pictures attached. If the book sells out we can order in it as we have done in previous years.

Alternatively, you can bring your receipt number and order to the office and we can arrange for you to collect (great if you would like the book as a gift), the office will not be accepting card payment.
