## **Principal's News**

#### **COVID Restrictions**

Earlier this term the Department of Education relaxed some restrictions around COVID-19. While this will mean we are now able to do some activities that we couldn't before, some of the safety measures are still in place. Please remember:

- Parents and community are not allowed in school grounds unless for educational purposes. If your child has forgotten something, such as a lunch, hat, lunch order or news item, parents **must** report to the office, they cannot just take it to the classroom or canteen.
- If your child is absent due to being sick with cold or flu like symptoms (runny nose, cough, sneeze, sore throat) they cannot return to school until they have a negative result in a COVID Test. This is a Department of Education policy that applies to staff as well.

## **Regrow Project**

Today classes started repotting the tube stock plants donated to us by Convoy of Hope, which we will be putting back into the community as part of the bushfire Regrow Project. Thank you to those who have sent in pots to help with the transplanting. The students had a great time today repotting with Kevin from Convoy of Hope and Von from the DPI Rural Recovery Support Service. We intend to have a plant stall day where people from the community can come and collect plants on Wednesday morning 2 December from our back fence along Captain Oldrey Oval.


