ICAS results

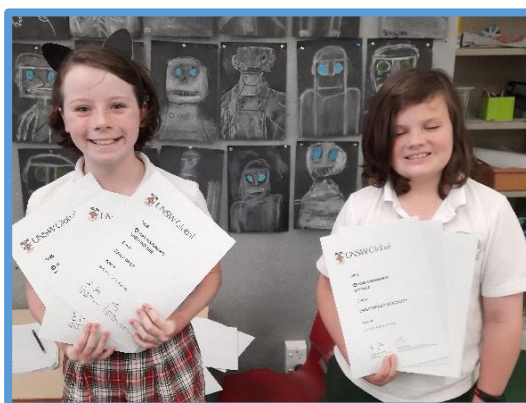

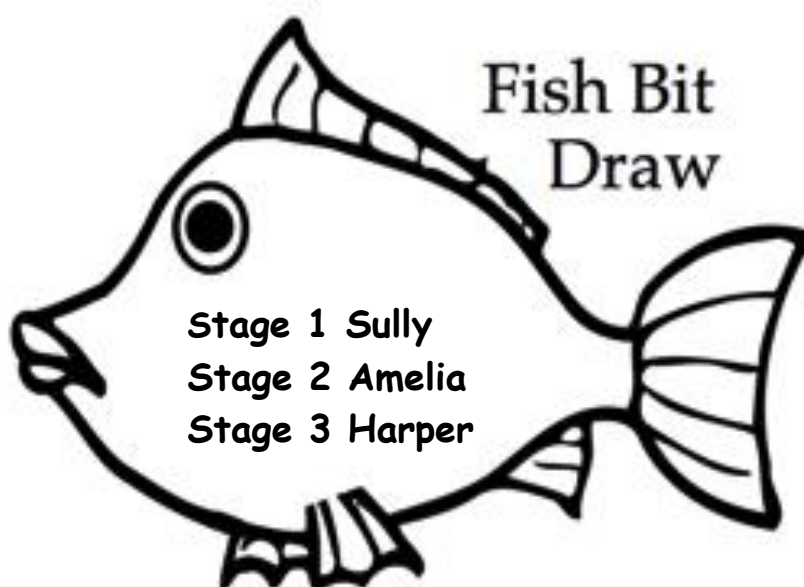
