## Harmony Day Celebrations

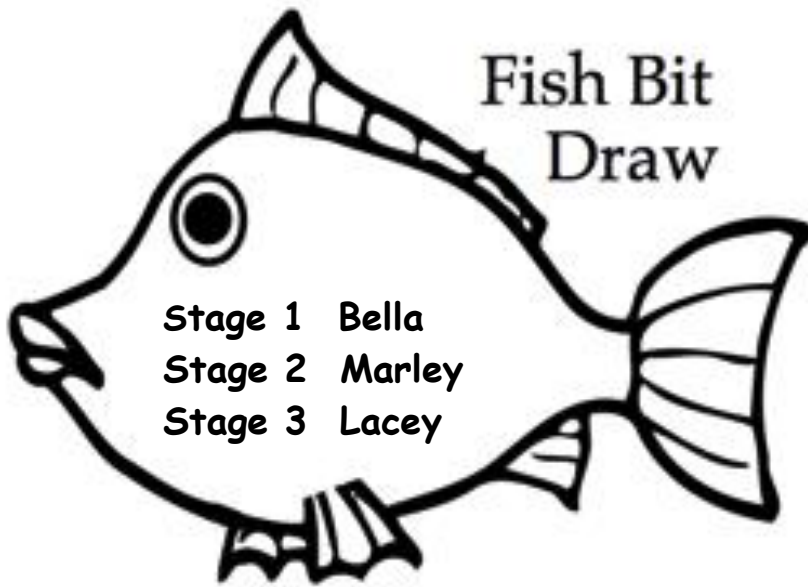
