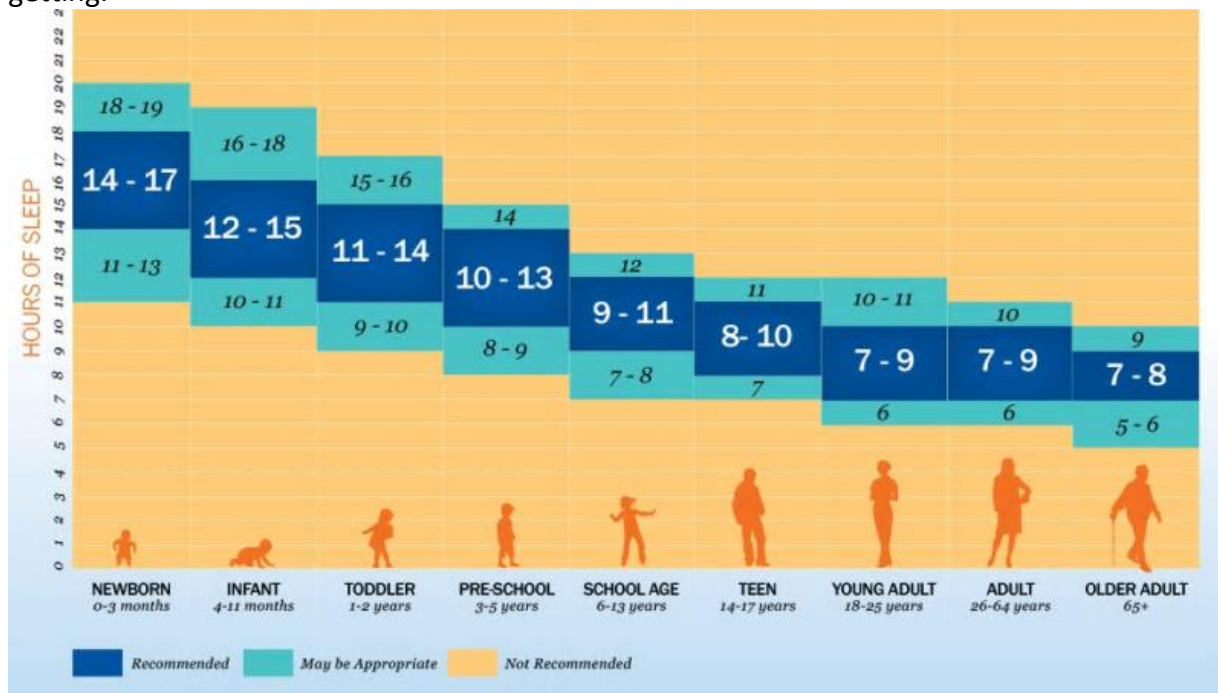
Updating Details
