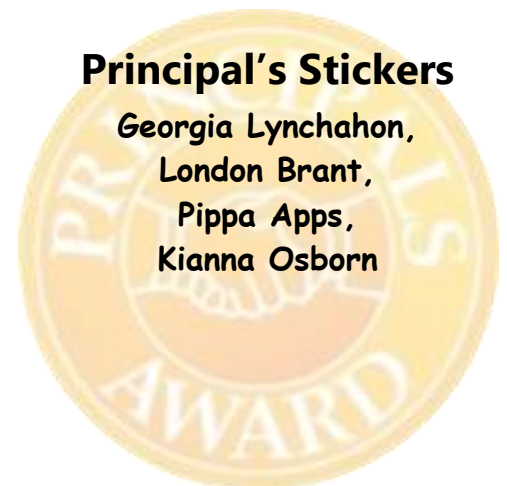
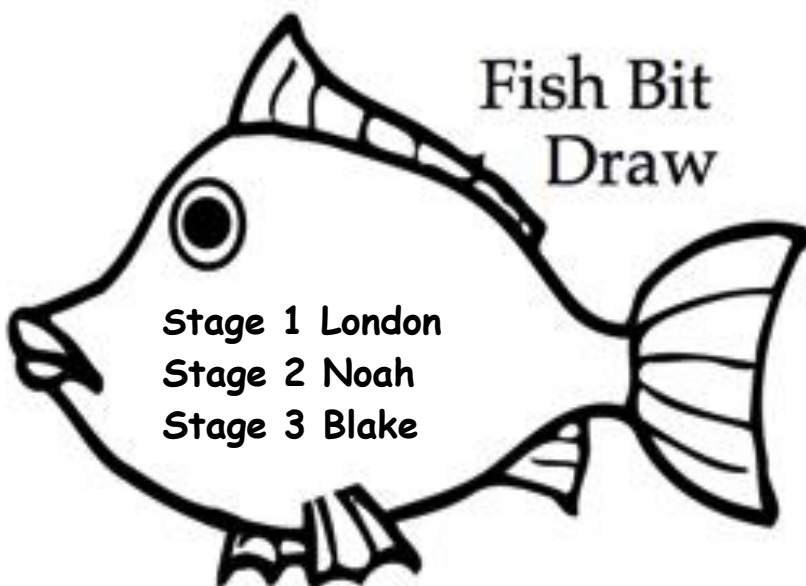

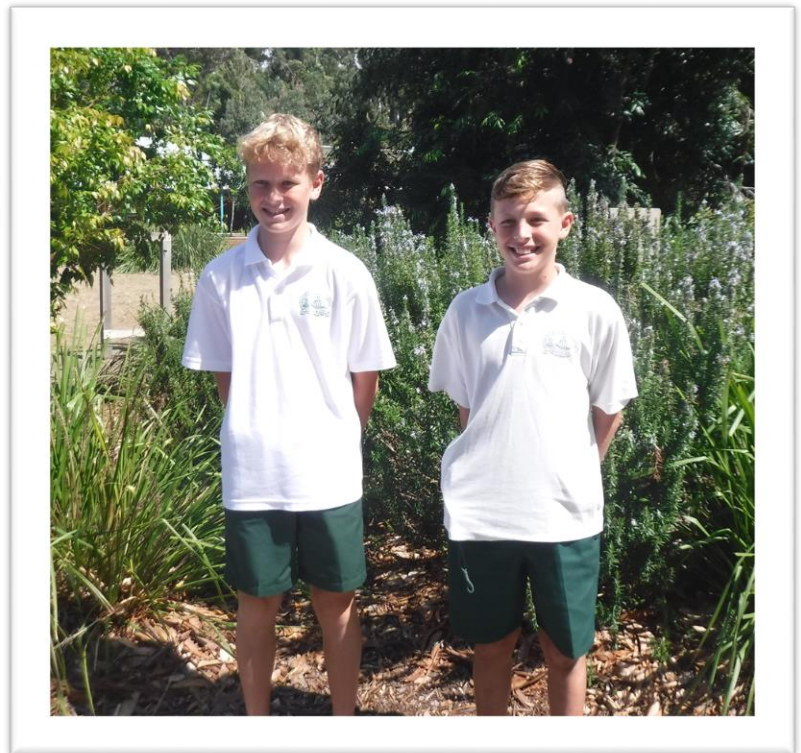

Start Date: 1st March 2021

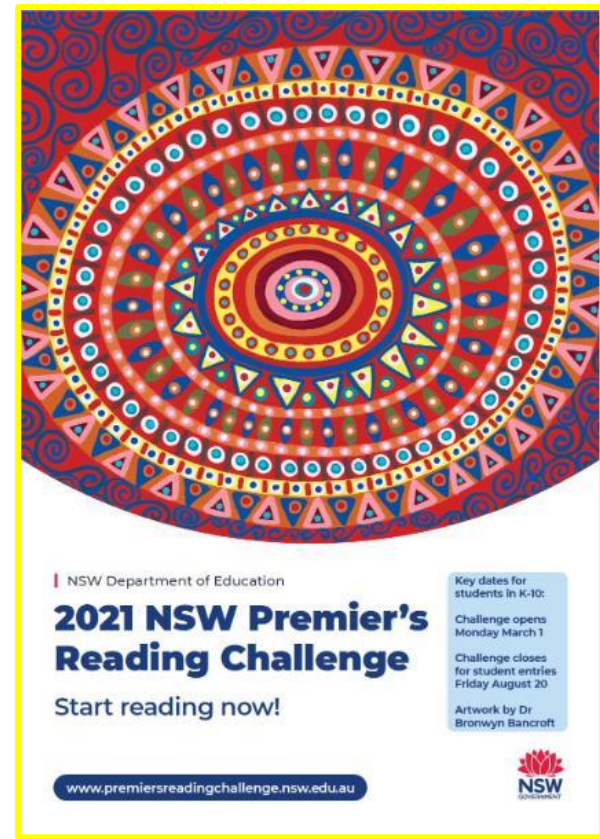
Finish Date: 20th August 2021
