Congratulations to everyone on a great term of learning. Learning from Home can be challenging in many ways, but it also brings out many great skills in our students.

They build on their skills to be good planners, structuring their day to get all the learning completed, breaking it up to do some of their favourite subjects between some of the ones they find more challenging. Getting the timing right so they don't miss their Zoom lessons and having the materials they need with them on the day (including theme days like the crazy hats or pets talking like a pirate...).

They become great problem solvers when they are finding materials to help complete learning tasks, thinking imaginatively in writing tasks, locating the links/daily messages on the Google Classroom and finding their way back to them when needed. Reading the question and instructions more than once to make sure they know what they are doing.

Learning from Home builds the resilience and perseverance muscles. When Zoom won't connect, when they can't find the post in the Google Classroom or the right page or activity in the learning packages. Those moments when Mum or Dad have been doing their own work and not been able to assist, they have had to rely on their resilience and perseverance to work it out.

These are all great achievements and learnings that our students, and all the parents and carers helping them, should be proud of. Even when things don't work out the way you hoped, our students are learning important skills that will help them in the future.

Learning Packs

Thank you again to everyone who returned their Learning from Home packs yesterday and picked up their Week 10 packs. Most students have now returned some learning for their teachers to mark which is important for our teachers to see how their students are going with the learning and put in adjustments or extra help where needed. It also assists the school in maintaining their attendance records, as no submitted learning indicates they have not been participating in school during the Learning from Home phase.

On Thursday and Friday, we will be placing class boxes out front of the school for students to **return their learning** from this week and any previous weeks. Please return any text books, learning packs and projects for marking over the holidays.

Current *Stay at Home* restrictions are in place into the school holidays. If they are lifted before the beginning of Term 4, students will return on Tuesday 5 October of Week 1 (Monday 4 October is the Labor Day Holiday) to Level 3 school operations. If *Stay at Home* restrictions stay in place, Learning from Home will continue and packs will be distributed in the same way as this term.
